LOAD: UN 1230, Methanol

Classification: 3, II, FT1

Marking : 1 blue cone(s)
(Attention! : the final marking is dependent on the total load (see 7.1.5.0))

DESCRIPTION:

Liquid. Mild, pleasant alcohol odour. Commercial/unpurified substance: irritating/pungent odour. Colourless. Soluble in water. Flashpoint: 11°C.

NATURE OF DANGER:

Highly flammable. Toxic by inhalation, in contact with skin and if swallowed. Toxic: danger of very serious irreversible effects through inhalation, in contact with skin and if swallowed. May be ignited by sparks. Gas/vapour explosive with air within explosion limits. On heating: release of toxic/corrosive/combustible gases/vapours formaldehyde. Upon combustion CO and CO₂ are formed.

PERSONAL PROTECTION:

For each member of the crew, a pair of protective goggles, a pair of protective gloves, a protective suit and a suitable pair of protective shoes; on board tank vessels, protective boots are required in all cases; a suitable escape device for each person on board; a flammable gas detector with the instructions for its use; a toximeter with the instructions for its use; a breathing apparatus ambient air-dependent.

GENERAL ACTIONS to be taken by the crew:

Stop the vessel as soon as possible and stop the engine. No naked lights. No smoking. Inform the public about the hazard and give advice to keep upwind. Warn the other vessels. Notify police and fire brigade as soon as possible: TEL 112 (*).

ADDITIONAL AND/OR SPECIAL ACTIONS to be taken by the crew:

Plug the leak, cut off the supply, provided that this can be achieved without personal risk. Dam up the spill, take up the spill into absorbent material.

FIRST AID:

After inhalation : remove the victim into fresh air.
After eye contact : wash immediately with lots of water.
After skin contact: wash immediately with lots of water and soap.
After ingestion : rinse mouth, give lots of water to drink; consult a doctor.

Additional information provided by manufacturer or sender:

Information for the fire brigade:

FIRE EXTINGUISHING MEDIA: Preferably: alcohol resistant foam.
Other extinguishing media: Water spray, BC powder, carbon dioxide. Solid water jet ineffective as extinguishing medium. Cool tanks/drums with water spray/remove them into safety. Take account of toxic firefighting water.
