As Methanex's President and Chief Executive Officer, John Floren has been with Methanex since 2000 and brings more than 30 years of diverse international management experience in the chemicals industry.

Before assuming his current role as President and CEO in 2013, Mr. Floren held a variety of positions with Methanex, including Senior Vice-President, Global Marketing and Logistics.

As the world's largest methanol producer and supplier, Methanex has continued to advance its long-term strategy and maintain its leadership position in the global methanol industry. In the last three years, Methanex has successfully grown its operating capacity by approximately three million tonnes by delivering on a number of value-added projects.

In 2013, the company added one million tonnes of operating capacity through growth projects completed in New Zealand and Medicine Hat. In 2015, the company successfully completed the relocation of two plants from Chile to Louisiana, adding two million tonnes of operating capacity.

Methanex maintains a strong financial position and is well positioned to continue to grow earnings and cash flows in the coming years.

Mr. Floren currently serves on the Board of West Fraser Timber Co. Ltd. His previous experience also includes the Chairman of the Methanol Institute, Director of the Formaldehyde Council and the PALS Autism School, as well as the Chair of the Standardbred Canada Audit and Finance Committee.

Mr. Floren earned his Bachelor of Arts in Economics from the University of Manitoba in 1987. He also attended Harvard Business School's Program for Management Development in 1998 as well as the International Executive Program at INSEAD in 2002. In 2012, he completed the Directors Education Program at the Institute of Corporate Directors. He is married and has two daughters.
